



Tarrant County Bar Foundation Janna Clarke Bench Bar Scholarship Fund

About the Janna Clarke Bench Bar Scholarship Fund:

The mission of the Janna Clarke Bench Bar Scholarship Fund is to honor Janna Clarke's legacy of involvement in and support of the Tarrant County legal community. Janna Clarke served as a leader and supporter of the Tarrant County Bar Association and Tarrant County Bar Foundation's various endeavors, and she routinely mentored other attorneys and individuals in the legal profession. The Janna Clarke Bench Bar Scholarship Fund is intended to provide female attorneys in Tarrant County with an opportunity to engage in bar activities and further their own professional pursuits by attending the Bar Association's annual Bench Bar Conference.

Upon timely and complete application submissions, scholarship recipients may receive full or partial scholarships to the Tarrant County Bench Bar conference. The Bench Bar registration includes the cost of lodging, meals, and the cost of the Bar Association's membership dues for non-members. If the applicant is not a current member of the Bar Association, the applicant may seek scholarship funds to cover the that portion of the registration upon demonstration of her intention to become involved in bar activities in the future. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the Tarrant County Bar Association to offset the applicant's registration cost.

The scholarship applications will be reviewed and approved by the Tarrant County Bar Foundation Board of Directors or its designees.

Eligibility:

1. The applicant must be a female attorney who practices law in Tarrant County.
2. The applicant must be an attorney in good standing with the State Bar of Texas.
3. Preference may be given to a female attorney who has exhibited a past history of involvement in TCBA activities, including membership in the Women Attorneys' Section.
4. The applicant cannot have already received a scholarship from the Janna Clarke Bench Bar Scholarship Fund. Scholarships are only awarded once per applicant.
5. Applicants must submit a timely and complete application as outlined in the registration form in order to be considered for the scholarship.
